Children in our After School Care Program are supervised using Waldorf inspired activities that compliment your child's school day. In order to accommodate the needs of today's families, two program locations are offered for children of all ages.

Nursery through Third Grade (N-3)

Younger students are cared for in the Betty Szold Krainis Early Childhood Building on Monday through Friday from 3:00 to 5:30 pm. Activities include a snack, crafts, and indoor and/or outdoor play. Children in our N-3 Program begin their afternoon with a nourishing and wholesome snack such as soup, popcorn or bread. While sitting around the table chatting about their day, they often appear like one big, happy family. Play is an important element of the afternoons' activities. Building with blocks, playing house, creating puppet plays, drawing, crafting with wool or finger knitting - the children are masters of play! Once inside toys are cleaned up the children don their season-appropriate outside gear and take to woods which are teeming with adventure. They run, jump, saw, dig, hammer and build to their hearts' content, finally making their way back to the school and waiting parents.

Fourth through Eighth Grades (4-8)

Older students in Fourth through Eighth Grade are supervised in the Elementary Building on Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday from 3:00 to 5:00 pm in conjunction with the After School Music Program. Students in our 4-8 Program are given time to work on homework, play inside or outside and enjoy a snack from their lunchboxes. On the days that children attend this program, please include a little extra healthy snack for after school appetites (no sweets, please).

Days of week: Tues, Weds, Thurs
Dates: September 8 through June 7
Location: Grade School Building

Parents can register for these programs in August by purchasing a prepaid card in \$40 increments from the business office. Cards will be debited in ½ hour increments by the After School Care supervisor for each child who attends the program. Registration information will be mailed to currently enrolled families in August. Questions about this program can be directed to the school office.
